




Ten years later in April 2013 the regulations come into force




What have we achieved so far?

In just 3 years we have achieved access to content which can be very complex, be in diverse formats and is forever changing.
















Metadata, Access and Printing







Including digital mapping and born digital sheet music; emerging formats

















Born Digital Sheet Music

More complex than digital maps since we don't already have a platform.


Engagement with the publishers is good although many didn't know they were liable.

These publication formats may be transient and complex in nature


