


Copyright Hub Services

- Provides infrastructure on the Internet
- Identify digital (or physical) content
- •The Hub makes the connection (resolves) back to a system that can tell you how it can be used
- Might offer licences
- Might tell you its free "if" / CreativeCommons
- Might just link back to contact details
- Freely Available
- Open source technology April

Copyright Hub Aims

- To open up new markets
- •To not interfere with existing business models
- To automate low value / high volume transactions
- •Cross border, industry led, voluntary, nonexclusive
- Encourages use of identifiers
- Funded by the creative industries




Working like the Internet




Working like the Internet


- Any identifiers can be used to resolve queries through the Copyright Hub
- They connect to multiple servers which know about the content ("repositories")
- The repositories are able to use a structured language about licences (ODRL just now)
- Rights work machine-to-machine
- Similar to how the Domain Name System works































Query the Licence

- Any identifiers can be used to resolve queries through the Copyright Hub
- Can be licence identifiers
- Repositories can reply with details of licence, using known standard
- Works machine-to-machine








Distributed Hub repositories
